

## What is War Child?

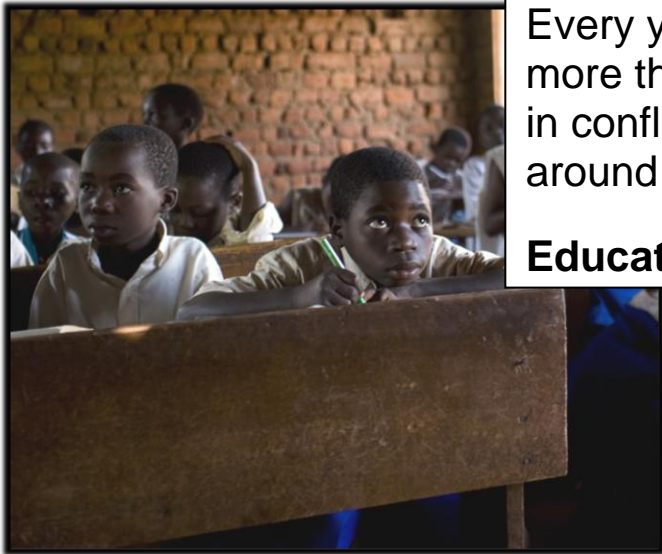

- Children are fighting in 17 conflicts worldwide
